After reading the three required books, each student entering **1st grade** is to complete a project about one of these books.

Dr. Seuss books

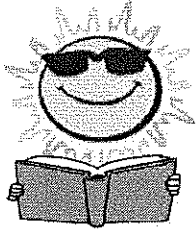

Summer Reading Paper Bag Project Requirements

- Decorate the outside of a large brown grocery bag with pictures and images that reflect from the story you chose! (Be creative!!)
- The title of the book and author's name should be displayed on the front of the brown paper bag
- Your child's first and last name should be written on the back of the brown paper bag
- Inside the bag, place 5 items that tell about the characters, settings, and/or events that happened in the story
- On the attached writing paper, students should write 2 sentences explaining why they chose this book for their report and what their favorite part of the story was.
