After reading the three required books, each student entering grade 2 is to complete a book report about one of these stories.

3. Play Ball Emilia Bedelia– by: Peggy Parish

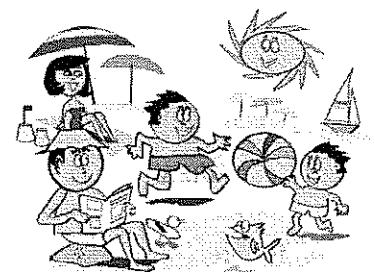
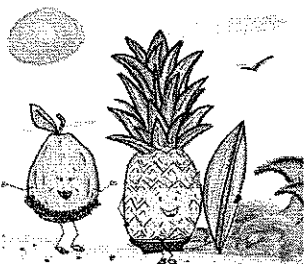
After the children read these three stories, they must choose one of the books to complete the attached book report. I have also attached a scoring rubric to the report so that you may see how the children will be graded.
